User Guides

Each month ten wells will be active on one Boston street. You can find the active wells in the list and map views.

- Active Street Cluster**
Street with interactive wells installed
- Zoom to view individual well locations
- Inactive Street Cluster**
Streets without interactive wells currently installed
- Click on the icon to view date of installation
- Active Well Nearby**
Well Location within Bluetooth Range
- Only visible when the Bluetooth on your mobile device is switched on
- Click on the active well to view the well elevation diagram
- Swipe down to update the water level reading
- Press the upload button to publish reading to the cloud
- Active Well out of Range**
Well Location currently out of Bluetooth Range
- Move closer to well location until within Bluetooth range
- Inactive Well Location**
Well Location currently out of Bluetooth Range
- Click on the icon to view date of installation

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7 Streets : 10 Wells : 28 weeks

Ten custom-designed, Bluetooth-enabled, translucent-Corian well caps will be on display on each of seven Boston streets for a period of four weeks. During that time, residents and visitors can see real-time groundwater level data digitally displayed on the face of Boston Groundwater Trust well caps and interact with the data through the BostonLightWells mobile app. Clicking on a LightWell within range displays a current reading along with the groundwater diagram. With your data-enabled mobile device, you can help us collect these data readings by selecting "upload" to publish the readings to the cloud.

Every four weeks, the ten well caps will be relocated to ten different Boston Groundwater Trust wells in the next street of the sequence. The time period for each street can be found under both the Well List and Well Map tabs. Help us crowdsource real time groundwater data! Follow the caps and publish the readings!
